

Niles

The Village of Niles, located only 15 miles from the Loop, is an excellent community for business, recreation, education and, of course, for raising a family.

Housing. Homes in Niles are about 30 years old. Ranches predominate in this area, but brick bungalows, bi-levels, split-levels, Cape Cods and Georgians are available.

Schools. Elementary school students attend schools in districts 63, 64, and 71. High school students go to Niles Township Community High School in district 219, which consists of Niles North and Niles West. Some students attend Maine East High School district 207.

Transportation. Both the Edens (I-94) and the Kennedy (I-90) Expressways are nearby for a 40-minute drive to the Loop. O'Hare Airport is a 15-minute drive, while a drive to Midway takes 45 minutes. Metra commuters reach the Loop in 24 minutes from the nearby stops at Park Ridge or Morton Grove. Niles provides free bus service to residents and commuter bus service is available.
